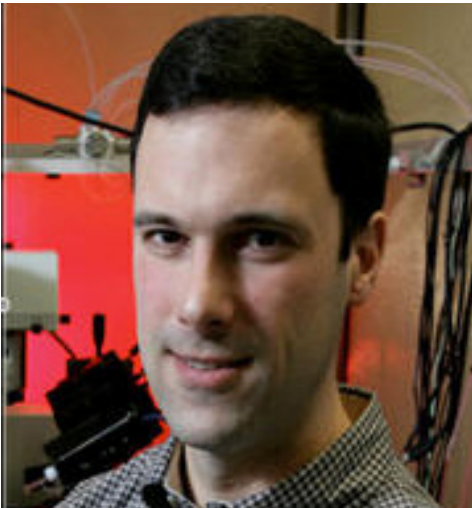


Networking Urban Resources with Teachers and University to enRich Early Childhood Science
